

How to find us....

By train:

Rugby is situated on the Birmingham - London mainline. Change at Birmingham New Street when coming from the North or West. From London, trains depart from Euston Station.

From the train station it is a short taxi ride or a 15 minute walk: turn right as you exit the train station onto Railway Terrace, follow this road uphill as it curves round to the left. Keep walking straight up the road approx 400 m and turn right onto Albert Street, follow the street uphill as it curves round to the left and meets Church St.

Turn right and cross over to the Church side of the road, take a left through the alley after the church which leads you onto Little Church St. You will find us about 200m up the road just past The Merchants Pub, Xolve is the last building on the right, before a red brick wall.

By car:

From the M6: exit at Junction 1 and follow directions along the A426 towards Rugby.

From the M1 (North): exit at Junction 20 and follow directions along A426 towards Rugby.

Entering Rugby: at the end of the dual carriage way (A426), bear left at the roundabout and passing under the railway bridge, continue up the hill. Continue straight over the next roundabout along Corporation Street, follow the road as it filters to the left and take the left on to Lawrence Sheriff Street (A428). Little Church Street is the second left turning after about 200m.

Parking:

Due to our city centre location, we unfortunately do not have any parking facilities. But there are several pay & display car parks nearby, all within walking distance. There is a small "short stay" pay and display car park across the street (number 7 on the map), otherwise any of the other town centre car parks are only a few minutes walk – the easiest is The Clock Towers (number 5), following the directions above as you enter Rugby, you will find it on the left hand side after the roundabout on Corporation Street. From there it is a short 2 minute walk: take a right turn as you exit the car park and walk through the shopping centre and into the Market Place. Turn right, then after 50 metres left between W H Smith and McDonalds towards Churchside Arcade; at the end of this short road you are in Little Church Street (you'll see the church on the left). Turn right, go past the back of M&S and then The Merchant's pub, another 20 metres and Xolve is the last building on the right, before a red brick wall.
